SERMON QUESTIONS:

We are challenging every group to read through Ephesians as we go through this series.
Before starting, pray for God to speak to you through this weeks message.

SCRIPTURE: Ephesians 2:1-10 (NIV).

DISCUSS: “To have a relationship with Jesus, you have to open the book.”

Q1 — What has God been teaching you in the Word of God recently?

Q2 — Has your approach to God been out of “duty” or has it been out of true desire? Why is that?

DISCUSS: “A relationship with Jesus is always a continuous relationship.”

Q3 — What tends to change your desire to want to spend time with Jesus? How can you make your relationship more than just your emotions?

DISCUSS: “You can’t receive the gift unless you know the Giver, and you can’t receive the grace unless you know the Truth.”

Q4 — Where in your life have you seen this statement come true?

DISCUSS: “Forgiveness isn’t the only thing that came from the cross. A new identity was given as God sees Jesus when He looks at us.”

Q5 — What freedom comes from knowing that God doesn’t look at you and see your past-self?

DISCUSS: “Faith is a response to the grace of God.”

Q6 — In your life, how can your faith come alive through praise?

Q7 — How can YOU serve God and others this week? How can YOU get out of your comfort zone?
