Facilitate conversations to help others live the life Jesus died and rose for them to live.
Create a safe place, encourage authenticity, celebrate breakthroughs, and lead the way!

SERMON QUESTIONS:

We are challenging every group to read through Ephesians as we go through this series.
Before starting, pray for God to speak to you through this weeks message.

SCRIPTURE: Ephesians 2:1-7 (NIV).

Q1 — Who is God to you?

DISCUSS: “This passage isn’t about what God has; it is about who God is.”

Q2 — What makes you believe that God only has a limited amount of mercy and grace?

Q3 — Do you have a poverty view of God?

DISCUSS: “You aren’t sinful because you do bad things. You’re sinful because you were born into a **dead** condition. Sin’s severity isn’t based upon the action but based upon the holiness of the one who is sinned against.”

Q4 — How does acknowledging the condition of sin (Romans 6: 23) lead you to overflowing thankfulness for the cross?

Q5 — Knowing that you have already been “made alive... saved...raised...and seated on the throne” because of Jesus’ blood, what kind freedom is God calling you to walk in today?

DISCUSS: “God didn’t become rich in mercy; He already is rich in mercy because it is who He already is.”

Q6 — How can you dive deeper into knowing who God is? What might be causing you to restrain from doing so?

DISCUSS: “The pathway to getting your heart enlightened to more of God is to ask God to do it.”

Q7 — God delights in the fact that there is forgiveness on your behalf. What do you need to repent of in order to fully embrace the grace of God?
