

# GOAL OF GROUP

EMPTY IS THE ENEMY

Facilitate conversations to help others live the life Jesus died and rose for them to live. Create a safe place, encourage authenticity, celebrate breakthroughs, and lead the way!

## SERMON QUESTIONS:

We are challenging every group to read through Ephesians as we go through this series. Before starting, pray for God to speak to you through this weeks message.

SCRIPTURE: **Ephesians 3 (NIV).**

**DISCUSS:** “It is a dangerous thing for what God is doing **THROUGH** you to outpace what God is doing **IN** you.”

Q1 — What causes spiritual emptiness in your life? What are some patterns you can identify in your life that cause you to become spiritually empty?

**DISCUSS:** “We tend to become disproportionately addicted to the activity.”

Q2 — Why is being **with** God greater than **doing** for God?

**DISCUSS:** “God created the Church to impart wisdom and to show off His glory to the darkness.”

Q3 — How have you made yourself available for God through the Church?

**DISCUSS:** “Don’t ever loosen the grip of the sovereignty of Jesus. When things get bad for Christians, things get better for the kingdom.”

Q4 — What times in your life has the sovereignty of Jesus been displayed at the same time as suffering?

**DISCUSS:** “Spiritual emptiness is always the byproduct of rooting your love for God instead of His love for you. God’s unconditional love **for** you, fill’s God’s immeasurable power **through** you.”

\*Read 1 John 4: 7-21 together as a group!

Q5 — Why is it important to understand that God loved us before we loved Him?

**DISCUSS:** “The pathway to your empty soul being filled is letting God love you.”

Q6 — What steps can you take to align your daily rhythm with Jesus?

Q7 — What is the importance of being in awe of the Lord?
