## SERMON QUESTIONS:

We are challenging every group to read through Ephesians as we go through this series.  
Before starting, pray for God to speak to you through this weeks message.

**SCRIPTURE:** Ephesians 4:17-32 (NIV).

**DISCUSS:** “To be completely unified, you have to be completely crucified.”

Q1 — What parts of your life have you not handed over to the Lord?

**DISCUSS:** “We are NOT unified together because we aren’t unified in ourselves.”

Q2 — How can you unify the parts that are divided within yourself?

**DISCUSS:** “Put off the old and pick up the new.”

Q3 — How can you begin to fully access your new identity in Christ and get rid of your old self?

**DISCUSS:** “Some of us have forsaken the pursuit of holiness and righteousness in the name of legalism.”

Q4 — How can your pursuit of holiness and righteousness become stronger?

**DISCUSS:** “Walk in the freedom of forgiveness. Hardened hearts lead to lonely lives.”

Q5 — Is there someone in your life that you need to forgive?

Q6 — How can you decide before an offense takes place, that you are going to forgive someone?

**DISCUSS:** “Forgiveness is not the agreement that the offense is okay, it’s the agreement that Jesus’s forgiveness is enough.”

Q7 — How begin to you walk in a constant spirit of forgiveness?
