WORTHY OF THE CALLING

Facilitate conversations to help others live the life Jesus died and rose for them to live.
Create a safe place, encourage authenticity, celebrate breakthroughs, and lead the way!

SERMON QUESTIONS:

We are challenging every group to read through Ephesians as we go through this series.
Before starting, pray for God to speak to you through this weeks message.

SCRIPTURE: Ephesians 4:1-16 (NIV).

DISCUSS: “Your calling isn’t a career, it’s a voice.”

Read Isaiah 30: 21 and John 14:6 with your group

Q1 — What does it mean that Jesus is the way?

Q2 — Knowing that your calling is a voice, how does that allow you to walk through in life knowing your freedom in Christ?

Q3 — Is your hope in **God** or is your hope that God will come through for you the way you want?

DISCUSS: “Living a worthy life isn’t about **action**, it’s about **attitude**.”

Q4 — Humble, gentle, patient, and fore-bearing one another in love: Which quality do you want to work on most?

Q5 — Are you making every effort to live the life that Jesus died for you to live? How can begin to do so?

DISCUSS: “Differences in our giftings free us up to be **ONE** in our calling. There are certain ways only you can reveal Jesus to others.”

Q6 — How can your differences free you up to become decisive, NOT divisive?

Q7 — What are certain ways that you are specifically gifted to reveal Jesus to others? How can you do that more?

Q8 — Ability: What are you good at?

Burden: What are you passionate about?

Confirmation: What do others say?

DISCUSS: “Church unity is an acknowledgement of how much we need each other.”

Q9 — In your life, do you have people that fight for you daily?
