SERMON QUESTIONS:

“Before starting, let me pray for us.”

SCRIPTURE: Luke 1 (NIV).

DISCUSS: “Whether or not you think you are highly favored is directly related to whether or not you hear from God.”

Q1 — How have your misconceptions about God affected you?

DISCUSS: “Just because God is silent doesn’t mean He isn’t **sovereign**.”

Q2 — Do you truly listen or are you waiting to talk? In the silence, do you fill it with noise?

DISCUSS: We always think Jesus can do the miraculous for other people but not for ourselves.

Q3 — What prayer do you think that God has not heard?

DISCUSS: “Prayer is not about God giving you what you want. Prayer is God getting you to want what He wants.”

Q4 — How does your prayer life need to change?

DISCUSS: “**God will give you enough clarity to take the next step but not enough clarity to remove faith.** You don’t need an answer from God, you need God. What if instead of asking for another sign, we took the **first step**.”

Q5 — What does that “first step” look like for you?

DISCUSS: “The enemy of favor is the **familiar**.”

Q6 — What have you become comfortable with in your life that is slowly in killing your soul?

Q7 — This week, how can you worship in the waiting and surrender in the silence?
