SERMON QUESTIONS:

“Before starting, let me pray for us.”

SCRIPTURE: Hebrews 6:19, Hebrews 11:1, Romans 4:18-21, John 1:1-14.

Q1 – What is the difference between faith and hope?

DISCUSS: “Even if you got everything you wanted in the world; you still wouldn’t be fulfilled. False hope is anything other than God.”

Q2 – What things do you tend to place your hope in other than the Lord?

DISCUSS: “Choosing hope is deciding that God’s promises are better.”

Q3 – What promise of God are you struggling to believe right now?

DISCUSS: “Hope is an anchor in the storm. The “friction” of this year can ignite the fire of faith in our lives that is bigger than our self.”

Q4 – Who do you know that needs to hear the gospel of Hope this week?

DISCUSS: “Hope is a spark igniting the fire of faith.”

Q5 – What “friction” of 2020 has the potential to ignite the fire of faith in your life?

DISCUSS: “Hope is a light shining in a dark world.”

Q6 – Entering into Christmas week, how can you be a light to your family and the people around you?
