SERMON QUESTIONS:

READ: Luke 19:11-27

Q1 — What was your biggest takeaway from the sermon?

Q2 — What is one way you can practically be a good steward this week?

Q3 — How would you describe stewardship before hearing this sermon?
What ways were you already exhibiting it?

DISCUSS: “Stewardship is the careful, responsible, and tactical management of something entrusted to one’s care.”

Did this challenge you in your belief of what stewardship is?

Q4 — Do you feel as though you are living intentionally in all areas? What may be barriers to this?

DISCUSS: “A reward of duty done is a duty to be done.” - An Ancient Jewish Saying

Q5 — “If you do not order your life in light of eternity, you will not be fully faithful with what is entrusted to you.”

How do you order or prioritize your life?

What priorities begin to slip as you become hurried, busy, or stressed?
