SERMON QUESTIONS:

"Before starting, let me pray for us."

SCRIPTURE: Romans 5; Matthew 6:25-34; Matthew 7:11

- Q1 If you could define the gospel in one sentence, what would that sentence say? Reflect on how you define the gospel and why it matters?
 - a. After this weeks message and reading Romans 5, how has your view of the gospel changed?
- Q2 Take a few minutes to think through "how much more" God has done for you. Go around the group and share the ways the Lord has illustrated this in your life.
- Q3 When was a time that you let the inconsistency of your past give you an impoverished view of God's grace? What will help you to remember God's grace is immeasurably more than the weight of sin?
 - a. Spend time sharing how good God has been to you in your life past, present, and future. Celebrate the joy of Jesus together.
- Q4 It is through this big view of grace that we find bold faith. What's God leading you to? Whats something so big that you haven't even prayed for it? Something so huge and specific. Give God an opportunity to move. Spend time praying for these things to happen. Believe in immeasurably more.
