GOAL OF GROUP

Facilitate conversations to help others live the life Jesus died and rose for them to live. Create a safe place, encourage authenticity, celebrate breakthroughs, and lead the way!

SERMON QUESTIONS:

“Before starting, let me pray for us.”

SCRIPTURE: Psalm 23; 1 Samuel 16:13; Revelation 7:15-17

DISCUSS: “I lack nothing when I embrace my need for God”

Q1 — What practices or habits can help us cultivate a deeper sense of surrender and trust in God's provision and care?

DISCUSS: “I lack nothing when I respond to the voice of God.”

Q2 — What was the last thing Jesus told you? Did you obey it?

DISCUSS: “I lack nothing when I step into the anointing of God.”

Q3 — What has God broken your heart for and called you to step into?

DISCUSS: “The experience of a sheep depends solely on the goodness of the shepherd.”

Q4 — What are some of the valleys or dark places that you have walked through in your life?

Q5 — How did you experience God's presence or absence during those times? How did you find the strength to trust in God during those times?

Q6 — Ask the room if anyone feels particularly in a valley. Spend time speaking life and praying for them. Maybe it has to do with provision, relationships, lies, or fear.

Q7 — Spend 15 minutes using Psalm 23 as a template for your time of prayer by praying through each line.
