SERMON QUESTIONS:

Q1 — What from the passage stood out to you the most?

Q2 — In which areas of your mind, body, and spirit are you compartmentalizing your spirituality?

Q3 — What of the three come more natural to you and which ones do you need to grow in?

DISCUSS: "Distant fathers are distracted with duty. Spiritual fathers are present with delight."

Q4 — How does this idea resonate with your own experiences from your father-figure relationships?

Q5 — In what areas could you step into more ownership in for the body of Christ?

ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS FOR FATHERS:

Q6 — What are some potential consequences when fathers become distant or overly consumed by their duties, as opposed to being present and engaged?

Q7 — In what ways can you extend the concept of spiritual fatherhood to other relationships, such as mentorship, beyond the traditional father-child dynamic?
