GOAL OF GROUP

Facilitate conversations to help others live the life Jesus died and rose for them to live. Create a safe place, encourage authenticity, celebrate breakthroughs, and lead the way!

SERMON QUESTIONS:

“Before starting, let me pray for us.”

SCRIPTURE: Acts 19:1-22; Colossians 2:13-15

Q1 — What was your reaction to the message from Sunday?

Q2 — If you had someone come to you that said they were struggling with something very difficult or even demonic, how would you handle it?

Q3 — Are there any ways in which you feel yourself or you see in culture how people are using Jesus' Name for their benefit without a personal relationship with Jesus?

Q4 — In what ways are you letting lies and/or agreement with the lies of the enemy hold you back from your life in Jesus?

Q5 — How can you redirect your fear to fear of the Lord? What is the fear of the Lord? (Proverbs 9:10, 19:23; Psalm 25:14, 34:9)

Q6 — “Live as a weapon against the darkness, not as a non-factor in the Kingdom of God”. How do you personally receive that? What challenge do you feel from the message after sitting with that statement?

CHALLENGE: Confession. Find a trusted friend and begin to commit to walking a road of honest reflection, confession, support, and encouragement. Some may need to first seek out deeper community if you cannot identify a person in your life that this would seem reasonable with.
